The Village In Howard has 115 members at the last count. About 80% are Associate Members and 20% are Full Members. We have 31 married couples and 53 single members (some of whom are married) with the majority of the single members being women. Of all members 78 are women and 37 men. The Membership Committee is tasked with adding to these numbers.

The Volunteer Committee consists of 40 Volunteers that keep the Village operational. The office volunteers keep the wheels turning, whether they are helping with mailings or responding to questions from the community or checking in with members to keep them involved. Transporta-

tion volunteers keep our members mobile by providing rides to medical or other appointments and are available to run errands as well. Many of our volunteers are
