TVIH New Center

For two years TVIH has enjoyed the hospitality of Winter Growth which donated office space so we could become operational. They have grown and TVIH has grown, so it is time to move across town to our new loca-



tion. TVIH is renting Stevens Forest Neighborhood Center, 6061 Stevens Forest Rd., Columbia near the pool and elementary school. New Benefit to Full Members "Circle of Care"

Beginning early in 2017, the Village will offer a new program called "Circle of Care." This program will provide coordinated services to full members following surgery, an accident or other traumatic event for a period of up to six weeks. Members needing these services will receive help that fills gaps in non-medical daily living tasks while they recover.

Currently, full members request individual services like transportation or help with a home repair, gardening or other tasks by calling or emailing the Village office and making each request separately. They are then contacted by the Village office when a volunteer responds that he/she can handle a task.

During a Circle of Care, members will not have to make individual requests for services. An assigned coordinator will assist them in determining what is needed and for how long. The Circle Coordinator will be the contact point for assembling a team to assist them. Members will receive a written schedule of volunteers who will perform specific tasks.

On a limited-time basis, Circle of Care may also provide services not normally available through the Village. These services might include services such as daily pet care, light housekeeping, and light meal preparation.

This is a "no-additional-cost benefit" of full membership in The Village! We will be presenting more details about this new program at our Town Hall Member Meeting on October 18th.

We are looking for members expecting to undergo planned medical procedures during the next 3 months who can help us Beta-test this process. If you are interested in helping (while receiving help), please contact Lois Huffman via the Village office at 443-367-9043.

New TVIH Membership Policies

Upgrading Membership: Associate members who wish to be up-graded to Full membership status (perhaps for an anticipated post-medical need) may pay a pro-rated portion of the \$200 difference for the remainder of their membership year in order to obtain full membership services.

Guest Attendance Limits: To encourage prospective members to join, The Village has allowed individuals to attend programs as a guest of a member. That will continue into 2017 but with a limit of a guest attending a maximum of 5 events each year. Nonmembers are welcome at open events such as Lunch Bunch, Sneakers and Coffee, and Happy Hour.

The Village in Howard now has 117 members.
