# **Tax Credit Deadline Extended**

The deadline for the "Aging-In-Place Tax Credit" has been extended to September 1st, 2017.

Residents are eligible if they are 65 years of age or older and have lived in their dwelling for 40 years or are a retired member of the military. The Tax Credit provides a 20% tax credit on up to \$500,000 of assessed property value. The credit may be granted for up to 5 years if the owner remains qualified; but a homeowner cannot receive this credit and the Senior Tax Credit

simultaneously. Visit *taxcredits.howardcountymd.gov* to read more about it and other tax credits for seniors. You can also call the Tax Credit line at 410-313-4076.


