Coming Soon...IMPORTANT New TVIH Website Privacy Protection Requirement

Our TVIH website will be upgraded soon with additional privacy policy features to conform to the new European standard. Changes to the website will take effect in the next few weeks. The most noticeable effect will be that members and volunteers will be asked to acknowledge and 'opt in' to a new privacy policy when trying to log into the website. *Anyone who 'opts out' will not be able to log in.* This process is necessary for your protection. Be sure to 'opt in' by answering the required yes/no questions or you will not be able to register for events, use the Forum or other features.
